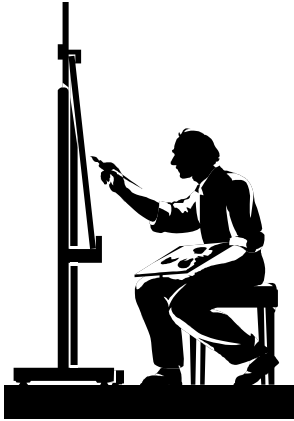


Learning Together at Fairview United Church in 2011–2012

Bible Study
