Program Overview:

GC Regular Meetings: Group Committee held monthly meetings the third Sunday of Sept 2009-June 2010 and commenced meetings again in Sept 2010 to Dec 2010.

Graham Robertson and Philip Landry continue to be very active leader volunteers with Beaver Colony. They bring their youth and enthusiasm to the Beaver meetings and outings.

2010 Financial Year End:
