Fairview is home to our excellent Fairview United Church Senior choir. Consisting currently of 13 members (Soprano, Alto and Bass), we welcome anyone with the desire to sing. We would dearly love to have anyone join us, but especially a tenor or two so that we can get back to singing our four part SATB choir music.

Practices are held on Thursday nights from 7:30-9 pm, September through June. Under the direction of our music director, Maureen McGee, the choir provides musical leadership for our 11 am services, as well as anthems and special music services throughout the year. One highlight is the annual Easter Cantata, which is performed on Good Friday. We also perform a Carols and Lessons service or smaller cantata at Christmas.

We welcome many special instrumental guests, choirs and soloists throughout the year. We are honoured to have Camerata Xara Women’s Choir twice a year as our special guests.

As well as our adult choir, Fairview also has a children’s/youth choir. Our Junior Choir, under the direction of Katrina Mills Pecknold performs at special services throughout the year. Youth from grades 2 and up are welcome to join this choir. Rehearsals are held certain Sundays throughout the year. Please contact the church to find out when the next rehearsal will be held.
