Some of the local charities that we do actively support are Halifax West Ecumenical Food Bank, Brunswick Street Campers, local hospitals and nursing homes and other local interests/charities. We do visit elderly and shut-ins throughout the year, especially at Easter and Christmas with cookie plates and cards.

We have three units that get together on different days and times (see meeting times below) from September to May. Each group has their own individual way of meeting, from craft evenings, having speakers, organizing events, baking, secret pals or just getting together for the fellowship and friendship. We hold two general meetings a year.
